**RESOLUTION FOR PUPIL TEXTBOOK AND
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SUFFICIENCY
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-18**

***Pursuant to Education Code Section 60119 & 60451
Resolution No. 2017-18-035***

WHEREAS, the local governing board of the Lake Elsinore Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing at a Board Meeting Thursday, September 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school and did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and:

WHEREAS, the local governing board provided at least ten days' notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places with the district that state the time, place and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the local governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home to complete required assignments, and:

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a standards-aligned textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and:

WHEREAS, sufficient textbook and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English Learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and are consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in Mathematics, Science, History-Social Science and English/Language Arts, including the English Language Development component of an adopted program, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil in Foreign Language or Health classes, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient laboratory Science equipment was provided for Science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for the 2017-18 school year, the Lake Elsinore Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
